FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed free choice as a creep feed while lambs are nursing. Lambs can be enticed to begin eating at an early age by offering a small amount of soybean meal in the creep feeder when the lambs are about 10 – 14 days of age. When lambs begin entering the creep feeder and consuming the soybean meal, begin offering Show Chow® Lamb Starter Pellet DQ next to the soybean meal. When lambs begin consuming the Show Chow® Lamb Starter Pellet DQ (usually in about 7 – 10 days after introduction) remove soybean meal from creep feeder.

Directions for use

Feed Show Chow® Lamb Starter Pellet DQ as a creep feed to lambs and as a starter feed after lambs have been weaned. Feed at the rate of 0.5 lbs per 30 lbs body weight to provide 22.7 mg Decoquinatone per 100 lbs body weight daily. Show Chow® Lamb Starter Pellet DQ may be fed for a longer time period where a high protein ration is desired before transitioning to Show Chow® Ultratoner 16 or Ultratoner 18. Always provide plenty of clean, fresh water. Feed at least 28 days during periods of exposure to coccidiosis or when it is likely to be a hazard.

Important:

1. Use Purina Mills® Show Chow® Lamb Starter Pellet DQ as a creep feed for rapidly growing young lambs prior to weaning.
2. When making a ration change, allow 3 to 5 days for animals to adjust to the new ration.
3. Keep a constant supply of complete feed available. Do not let fine material accumulate in feeders.
4. Provide adequate, well-protected and well-managed bunk space for each animal to prevent feed from becoming wet or moldy.
5. Provide a source of fresh, clean water at all times.
6. Feed salt free-choice.
7. Consult your veterinarian for the recommended health program for your local area. This includes internal and external parasite control.

Caution:

DO NOT USE IN FEEDS CONTAINING BENTONITE.

Store in a dry, well-ventilated area free from all rodents and insects. Do not use moldy or insect-infested feed.
